

Filer Police Department Activity Report for November, 2017

Mayor & City Council,

As you know I started on 11/13/17 and was initially overwhelmed with information. I have acclimated and I'm progressing daily. I have reviewed what we're doing and how we're doing it, and I'm making changes as needed. Of note we are in the process of becoming uniform in our appearance, in what we do and how we do it.

As previously briefed, we received the grant requested NARCAN (Naloxone) to help us to help those in the community afflicted by drug overdose. There is a box of two treatments in each patrol unit.

During this quarter we will be assisting Filer High School with their Forensics/Crime Scene class as we've done in the past. These assists will occur only during shifts when we're available.

Next weekend Sgt. Darnall and Cpl. Hassani will be attending an Incident Command Class at the Filer Fire Department. This is part of the Incident Command training put on by FEMA.

In the interest of cooperation the Filer Police Department traded some surplus radios to the Filer Fire Department in exchange for a kick screen to be put into FPD 1600 Patrol Unit. The kick screen is needed for officer safety.

Police Patrol Activity

During November 2017 the Filer Police Department handled 487 calls for service. Of those there were 221 traffic stops, which resulted in 3 DUI arrests and 5 driving without privileges (DWP) arrests/citations, 2, 2nd offence insurance violations, 2 Minor Possession/Consumption violations, 1 Domestic Violence violation, 1 Possession of Drug Paraphernalia violation, and 1 Failure to Purchase a Drivers License violation. There were also 31 traffic infraction citations issued, and there was 1 Juvenile/Felony arrest for Drug offences.

Other calls of note;

Theft/Burglary calls – 3 (all of these calls turned out to be medical/mental in nature)

Dog Calls – 15

Citizen Assists/Info Calls – 28 (VIN checks, Information, and vehicle lockouts)

Motorist Assist Calls – 8 (disabled vehicles)

Total Patrol Miles – 5201
